NEW SOUND SYSTEM

In the new year we will be starting a campaign to raise funds for a new and improved sound system for the parish. We had a sound engineer come in and look at the current system and we were told that at best we would get a 10% improvement if we tried rebalancing what we have. Apparently, we were given a one size fits all model which was not designed for the contours of church space. A new system, designed for our worship space, will cost approximately \$50,000. We are hoping to raise half of this cost with new donations and pay the rest from our savings. You can make a donation specifically for the sound system by visiting the parish office during office hours or you could put a donation in the basket at Mass in a **different envelope** written in bold (with your envelope number). **Please specifically state that the donation is for the sound system** since 100% of all monies raised for a specific project goes directly towards that project and no portion of it will taken by the Archdiocesan parish assessment.
