



THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST SUNDAY JUNE 22, 2025 Gospel Reading – Luke 9:11b-17 They all ate and were satisfied.

Today, the Second Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate a Second Solemnity, which marks our return to Ordinary Time. Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. At one time, this day was called Corpus Christi, Latin for "the Body of Christ." In the most recent revision of the Liturgy, the name for this day is expanded to be a more complete reflection of our Eucharistic Theology.

The feeding of the 5,000 is the only one of Jesus' miracles to appear in all four Gospels. Luke places it between Herod's question, "Who is this about whom I hear such things?" and Peter's response to Jesus' question about who he thought Jesus was: "You are the Messiah of God." In Luke the feeding is not the result of Jesus' compassion for the crowd but is instigated by the disciples. They wanted Jesus to send the crowd away to town. Instead, Jesus tells the disciples to give them some food on their own.

This passage is meant to remind us of two feedings in the Old Testament: the feeding of the Israelites in the desert and Elisha's feeding of 100 people with 20 loaves in 2 Kings 4:42-44. It is also connected to the institution of the Eucharist. As in the Last Supper accounts in Matthew, Mark and Luke and in Paul's account in 1 Corinthians 11:24-24, Jesus takes bread, looks up to heaven, blessed the bread, breaks it and then gives it to the disciples. In using this exact language, Luke is reminding his readers that in this miracle Jesus is doing more than feeding hungry people as God did for the Israelites and the prophet Elisha did as well. The bread He gives is His Body, which He will continue to give as often as the community Breaks Bread in remembrance of Him in the Eucharist.

### **SIDE-BY-SIDE COMPARISON** OF OUR SUNDAY PRINTED BULLETIN VS. OUR ONLINE PARISH WEBSITE BULLETIN

**NOTE:** Below is for comparative purposes/to inform only. Please support our local parishioners/businesses who sponsor our parish bulletin. It is through their efforts that we are able to distribute free Sunday bulletins at our weekend Masses. *When comparing the two bulletins, there are a few differences:* 

- The printed bulletin is only in black-and-white.
- The online bulletin is in **color**.
- The printed bulletin can only be two pages long (due to space limitations).
- The online bulletin length is usually between 4-6 pages long and "goes deeper" into extended content.
- The printed bulletin contains no clickable links; QR codes are created so one can scan for more details/graphics/links.
- The online bulletin contains multiple clickable links (blue color in the chart).

- The printed bulletin may contain errors/spelling mistakes that may have been missed prior to sending it out to be printed.

- The online bulletin can be/is routinely updated to correct all such mistakes. If mistakes ARE found after uploading it to our parish website, corrections are made and a "revised" PDF bulletin is re-uploaded to the website.

\* The printed bulletin is available weekly in our church in time for the Saturday (evening) and Sunday (morning) Masses.

\* The online bulletin is usually always uploaded to our parish website on Friday morning.
