From Our Pastor ...

SIGNIFICANT MILESTONES IN THE BASIL BREEN ERA

Mr. Neil Ishmael, an enthusiastic parishioner and devoted member of the Knights of Columbus at St. Thomas the Apostle Church, revisited some of his cherished memories from the past, retracing his steps back to the years 1983 to 1984, when he was a vibrant young man in his twenties. His family joined the parish in November 1983.

Mr. Ishmael recalled, "Fr. J. Basil Breen regularly celebrated Sunday Masses in the auditorium of Mother Teresa School. Each weekend, parishioners would help carry the chairs from downstairs, set them up in the auditorium for Holy Mass, and then store them away again after the last Mass."

At the end of the Advent season in 1983, the parish community held a second Mass for the first time—its very first Midnight Mass. In addition to the usual 6:00 p.m. Mass on Christmas Eve, Fr. Breen fittingly named this new celebration the 'Christmas Family Mass.'

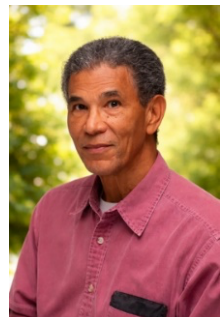
Under the leadership of Sr. Addolorata, and assisted by other nuns, the Children's Choir presented a delightful Christmas Pageant and sang beautiful carols for nearly an hour before Midnight Mass. To the awe and admiration of the congregation, the most remarkable aspect of these carols was their rendition in many languages, reflecting the rich multicultural spirit of the young parish community at the newly founded Church of St. Thomas the Apostle.

In its early years, the parish gratefully remembered the generous assistance and support it received from many clergy. The Brazilians, the White Fathers, and several diocesan priests helped celebrate Holy Mass, delivered homilies, assisted with confessions, and administered the Sacrament of Baptism. Among them was Fr. Pierangelo Paternieri of the Scalabrini Fathers, and Fr. Luigi Galanti, Associate Pastor of St. Mary Immaculate, Richmond Hill, who celebrated the Monday evening Mass in Italian—the "house language" of the daughters of St. Mary of Leuca. *To be continued*
