
PASTOR'S NOTES ON OUR CHURCH'S HISTORY

THE FIRST MEMORABLE YEAR - 1982-1983

Many memorable events have been recorded in the brief history of the foundational first year of the Church. At the Solemn celebration of Easter, several Ushers, Lectors, and Musicians shared in the Liturgical Celebration. In the same year forty-seven students received the Sacrament of Confirmation. A record number of one hundred children received their First Holy Communion. A Bible Study Group for Italian parishioners was organized by Fr. Siro and for the English-speaking community the "Word of Life" program was inaugurated at the parish. Sr. Addolorata of the Daughters of St. Leuca began Saturday Catechism classes in October. More than thirty families came for these classes taught by Mrs. Teresa Kong for the Chinese-speaking families.

The first Anniversary of the founding of the Parish was graced by Most Rev. Robert Clune, Auxiliary Bishop of Toronto and Bishop in charge of the Eastern Region of the Archdiocese. Today Bishop Clune is remembered by some Senior members of our Congregation for the wonderful conversations they had with him about his Episcopal ministry in the Eastern Region. The Sacrament of baptism was administered to a good number of children in 1982-83. These children are now energetic young women and men in their early forties! Today some of them shoulder many responsibilities at our Church as exemplary leaders.
