O Sacred Heart - Entrance Hymn

Verse 1:

Invocation of the Holy Spirit

Leader:

Come, O Holy Spirit, / fill the hearts of Thy faithful / and enkindle in them, / the fire of Thy love.

Send forth Thy Spirit / and they shall be created.

AII:

And Thou shalt renew the face of the earth.

Leader:

Let us pray...

AII:

O God, Who, by the light of the Holy Spirit, / didst instruct the hearts of the faithful, / grant that in the Same Spirit, / we may be truly wise, / and ever rejoice in His consolation, / through Christ Our Lord. Amen.

Act of Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

AII:

Lord Jesus Christ, I consecrate myself today anew, / and without reserve to Your Divine Heart. / I consecrate to You my body with all its senses, / my soul with all its faculties, / my entire being. / I consecrate to You all my thoughts, words, and deeds, / all my sufferings and labours, / all my hopes, consolations, and joys. In particular, I consecrate to You this poor heart of mine / so that it may love only You / and may be consumed as a victim in the fire of Your love.

I place my trust in You without reserve / and I hope for the remission of my sins / through Your infinite mercy. / I place within Your hands / all my cares and anxieties. / I promise to love You / and to honour You / 'till the last moment of my life, / and to spread, as much as I can, / devotion to Your Most Sacred Heart.

Do with me what You will, / my Jesus. I deserve no other reward / except Your greater glory and Your Holy Love. / Take this offering of myself / and give me a place within Your Divine Heart forever. Amen.

Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

AII:

Divine Saviour of souls, / with countenances covered with confusion, / we prostrate ourselves in Your Sovereign Presence. / Our thoughts are directed / toward the solitary tabernacles / where You, imprisoned, / sigh for our love.

Heartbroken, we grieve at Your sight / forgotten by those whom You have redeemed; / Your Blood made void, / Your sacrifices fruitless, / Your Love derided. / Yet, since in Your infinite condescension, / You permit us tonight, / to unite our sighs with Yours, / our tears with the tears / which, for our sake, fell from Your Most Sacred Eyes / and with the drops of blood, / which poured out from Your Divine Heart, / we pray to You, Sweet Jesus, / for those who do not pray to You; / we bless You, in place of those

who curse You; / we adore You, for those who outrage You. / With every power of souls, / in all the moments of this night, / and before all the tabernacles of the world, / in union with the efficacious desires of Your Loving Heart, / we wish to bless and praise You.

Leader:

O Lord, may the cry of expiation and repentance, / which rise from our contrite hearts, / ascend to You!

AII:

Amen.

Petition to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

AII:

O Lord Jesus Christ, / You have promised that, / where two or more / are gathered in Your Name, / You will be in the midst of them. / Look down, then, / with love and compassion / upon us here before You, / to honour Your Sacred Heart / and to make it known and loved by all. / Come into our midst, gentle Jesus, / fill our hearts with blessings / and inflame them with Your love!

Leader:

O Jesus, look upon those / who kneel before You.

AII:

Heart of Jesus, / hear and grant our prayers. Amen.

AII:

Divine Heart of Jesus, / to You we have recourse. / In You, we find consolation when afflicted, / protection when persecuted, / strength when overwhelmed with trials / and light in doubt and

darkness. We firmly believe / You can bestow on us, / the graces we implore. / We are most unworthy of Your favours, / but You are the God of mercies / and will not refuse a contrite and humble heart. Remembering Your words: / "Ask and you will receive, / seek and you will find, / knock and it will be opened to you;" / mindful too, that from Your Sacred Heart / have come words of tenderness and pleading love: / "Come to Me, all you who labour / and are burdened, / and I will refresh you"; / We come to You now / with childlike confidence / to make our pleas in this Holy Hour (pause here to make your petition). But, if what we ask / is not for Your Glory, O God, / and the saving of souls, / answer our prayer / in the way You know best. / Whatever may be Your decision / with regard to our requests, / we will never cease to adore, love, and serve You. Amen.

AII:

Heart of Jesus, / hear and grant our prayers. Amen.

In the presence of all the heavenly court, / I choose Thee this day / for my Mother and Mistress. / I deliver and consecrate to Thee, / as Thy slave, / my body and soul, / my goods, both interior and exterior, / and even the value of all my good actions, / past, present, and future; / leaving to Thee, / the entire and full right / of disposing of me, / and all that belongs to me, / without exception, / according to Thy good pleasure, / for the Greater Glory of God, / in time and in eternity. Amen.

I adore Thee, / I praise Thee, / I love Thee. / I thank Thee, O Sacred Heart of Jesus / penetrated with sorrow / at the thought of so many sins and offenses / which have been committed against Thee / in the most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. / I offer Thee the most Holy Heart of Thy Beloved Mother / with the merits of the Saints in reparation for them.

Leader (red beads):

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, burning with love for us,

All (response):

Inflame our hearts with love for Thee!

All (each white bead):

I adore Thee, / I praise Thee, / I love Thee. / I thank Thee, O Sacred Heart of Jesus / penetrated with sorrow / at the thought of so many sins and offenses / which have been committed against Thee / in the most Holy Sacrament of the Altar. / I offer Thee the most Holy Heart of Thy Beloved Mother / with the merits of the Saints / in reparation for them.

Leader (6 red beads):

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, burning with love for us,

All (response):

Inflame our hearts with love for Thee!

All (the middle medal):

May the Sacred Heart of Jesus / present in the the most Holy Sacrament of the Altar / be praised, loved, and adored / with grateful affection / in all the tabernacles of the world / even to the end of time. Amen.

Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

AII:

Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary, / I consecrate my entire self to the Most Holy Love of Your Two Hearts. / I wish to make

reparation / for all the sins of the world, / including my own. / I offer these things / for the love of the hearts of Jesus and Mary.

I will keep my mind on beauty / and turn my thoughts from evil things. / I will hold my temper / and bear the mistakes of others with love and a forgiving heart. / I will admit when I am wrong / and ask others to forgive me. I will not show off, / but remain humble. / I will offer up all my sufferings, / sickness and hurts.

I will seek God's Will, / not my own. / I will show appreciation for the kindness, / the blessings that I receive, / and thank God for all things. / I will do everything in my life for love of God. / And, I will



The Promises of Our Lord to St. Margaret Mary for Souls Devoted to His Most Sacred Heart

- 1) I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- 2) I will establish peace in their homes.
- 3) I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
- 4) I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all in death.
- 5) I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
- 6) Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7) Tepid souls shall become fervant.
- 8) Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
- 9) I will bless every place in which an Image of my Heart shall be exposed and honoured.

- **10)** I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11) Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in my Heart, never to be effaced.
- 12) I promise thee in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate on the First Friday in nine consecutive months the grace of final penitence; they shall not die in my disgrace nor without receiving their Sacraments. My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in their last moment.

The 15 Promises of Mary to Christians Who Recite the Rosary

(given to St. Dominic and Blessed Alan)

- 1) Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary, shall receive signal graces.
- 2) I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.
- 3) The Rosary shall be a powerful armour against Hell; it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat Heresies.
- 4) It will cause Virtue and Good Works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire of eternal things. O, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.
- 5) The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary, shall not perish.
- 6) Whoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its Sacred Mysteries, shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His Justice, he shall not perish by an unprovided death; if he be just, he shall remain in the grace of God, and become worthy of eternal life.
- 7) Whoever shall have a true devotion for the Rosary shall not die without the Sacraments of the Church.

- 8) Those who are faithful to recite the Rosary shall have, during their life and at their death, the Light of God and the plentitude of His Graces; at the moment of death, they shall participate in the merits of the Saints in Paradise.
- 9) I shall deliver from Purgatory those who have been devoted to the Rosary.
- **10)** The faithful children of the Rosary shall merit a high degree of Glory in Heaven.
- 11) You shall obtain all you ask of me by the recitation of the Rosary.
- **12)** All those who propagate the Holy Rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.
- 13) I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors, the entire celestial court during their life and at the hour of death.
- 14) All who recite the Rosary are my sons, and brothers of my only Son, Jesus Christ.
- **15)** Devotion to my Rosary is a great sign of predestination.
